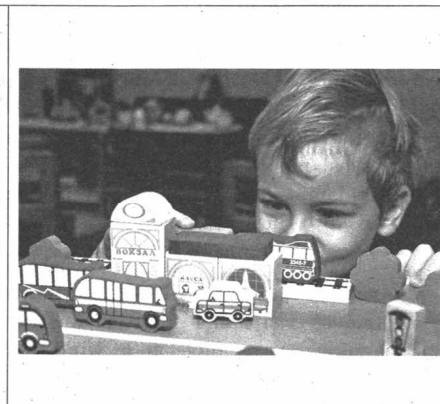

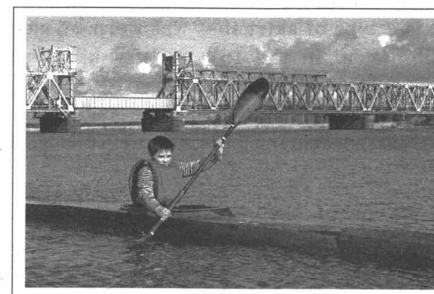

- A. Scotland is located in the north of the British Isles. In the north and west of Scotland are the Scottish Highlands. This historic region of Scotland has many mountains, including Ben Nevis, the highest mountain in the British Isles. Very few people live in the Highlands, most of them left this region in the 19th century and moved to the US, Canada, Australia and other places.
- B. An important part of Scottish culture is their music. The most famous traditional Scottish instrument is the Great Highland bagpipe. A bagpipe is a wind instrument that is made from a series of pipes which are fed by air in a bag. It was first used in the army, but nowadays bagpipe bands have become more and more popular and have spread throughout the world.
- C. The most well-known part of traditional Scottish clothing is the kilt. A kilt is a type of skirt that was worn by men and boys in the Scottish Highlands. In the 16th century kilts were much longer. The modern, shorter kilt came in the 18th century. Nowadays the kilt is most often worn on formal occasions, but recently more people have started wearing kilts as an everyday item of clothing.
- D. Loch Ness is one of the most famous lakes of Scotland. It is famous for the Loch Ness Monster, sometimes called Nessie. Nessie is described as a large animal with a very long neck. Throughout history people have claimed to have seen the Loch Ness Monster, but scientists say that none of their proof is real.

- E. Robert Burns is the most well-known poet who wrote in the Scots, a language spoken in Lowland Scotland. Burns also wrote in English with a Scots dialect and in standard English. Besides writing poems, Burns also collected traditional Scottish folk songs and adapted them. To this day Robert Burns is a cultural icon to all the people of Scotland.

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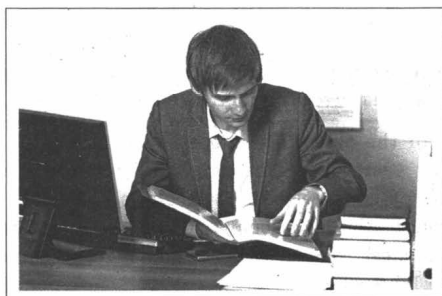

A. Hawaii is a collection of six small islands near the centre of the Pacific Ocean. It is always warm in Hawaii, and the islands are very beautiful. On some of the islands, the sand on the beaches is not only white, but also black, red and even green. The Big Island of Hawaii is known for its active volcano. Lava flows out of it every day and makes the island grow.

B. Because Hawaii is so beautiful and warm, it is one of the tourists' favourite places to visit. Millions of tourists visit the islands every year. This creates ecological problems. Big hotels are built in the most beautiful areas, the air and the water are becoming less clean. More and more people move to Hawaii to work in the tourist industry. The traditional Hawaiian culture is disappearing.

C. Hawaiian language is very unique. There are only twelve letters in the Hawaiian alphabet: A, E, O, I, U, K, L, M, N, P, H, and W. This makes it very difficult to translate some of the names and words from other languages. "David", for example, is translated into Hawaiian as "Kawika", since there is no D sound. And "Merry Christmas" is "Mele Kalikimaka"!

D. Hawaiian culture is famous for its beautiful music. The style of slack-key guitar is well-known around the world and is often used in Hollywood films. The ukulele — a very small guitar with only four strings — is a traditional Hawaiian musical instrument which is becoming more and more popular in many countries. Queen Lili'uokalani, the last Hawaiian queen, was a musician and composer. Her song "Aloha 'Oe" has become a symbol of Hawaii.

E. There is a big American naval military base on the island of Oahu called Pearl Harbour. This place has a sad history. During the Second World War, early in the morning of December 7, 1941, Japanese planes bombed Pearl Harbour. This was a surprise attack. The American military were not expecting it, and as a result, most American Pacific fleet was destroyed. This attack made the USA declare war on Japan and Germany.

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Vasnetsov Museum

There is a very unusual house in the center of Moscow. It A _____ like the other houses around it. It looks like a house from a Russian fairy tale. The famous Russian artist Victor Vasnetsov B _____ in this house with his family more than 100 years ago. Victor Vasnetsov loved Russian fairy tales, and C _____ of his pictures are based on them. The top floor of this house is Vasnetsov's studio where he worked on some of his famous pictures: "Alyonushka", "Ivan-Tsarevitch Riding the Gray Wolf", and others. Some of these pictures are still in this studio. Many tourists believe that this is one of the E _____ museums in Moscow.
